LITERACY

Literacy

This term the children will continue to explore a variety of texts and take these home to share with their families. They will be reading daily in class and will complete short associated tasks to develop their comprehension skills.

The children will be working on personal writing through recording their news, we will also be linking our writing to our Vikings topic. We will explore non-fiction texts and look at gathering and organising information from these.

We will be developing our grammar skills and focusing on our sentence structure, capital letters, proper nouns and common nouns.
