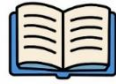


Tayvallich Primary School Curriculum Overview

Literacy



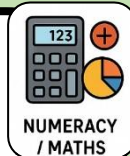
LITERACY

With a focus on learning about our community we will use non-fiction text this term develop a range of literacy skills including skimming and scanning to find relevant information from a range of sources. We will work on organising the information gathered to create notes on a subject to show our understanding.

We will use own notes and knowledge gathered to create new texts, expanding our understanding of subject specific vocabulary to suit purpose and audience. We will also develop our understanding of fact and opinion in order to identify reliable sources. Additionally we will expand our knowledge of persuasive writing and letter writing.

Spelling in the first term will focus on filling gaps where they have been identified through assessment, before moving onto expanding our knowledge of spelling patterns, rules and strategies.

Numeracy and Maths



NUMERACY / MATHS

We will revise our knowledge of place value and expand this to include numbers up to 7 digits as appropriate. We will begin to round increasingly complex numbers including decimals.

After consolidating these key skills, we will develop our knowledge of the four operations, addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

We will continue to develop our understanding and knowledge of maps and will describe plots and use coordinate notation to record the location of a point. We will interpret maps, models or plans with simple scales, for example, 1 cm:2 km and begin creating our own scale models and maps.

French

This term we will be focussing on conversational French and consolidating the vocabulary we have learnt this far.

Gaelic:

This term we will consolidate our previously learnt vocabulary and begin to put this into sentences.



LANGUAGES

PE

This term for P.E. we are learning about working well as a team and positive communication while playing through a number of collaborative games. We will also learn some more ceilidh dances.

Health and Wellbeing

We begin the new school term by revising our school rules and expectations of being a good friend. We will learn what this means and how we can be one everyday. We will also continue the RSHP curriculum.



HEALTH AND WELLBEING

Topic (Our Community)



TOPIC

This term we are focusing our learning around our community and what makes it special. We will be showcasing this work through a short documentary film. In making the documentary we will learn about film types and the features of documentary films. We will explore the different roles needed in making a documentary and take turns to fulfil each one. For example, director, camera operator, script writer. We will also develop our ability to discuss what we like and do not like about a variety of films including our own work.

We will also explore our local area and use this to extend our mental map of Tayvallich, Argyll, Scotland and beyond.



ART

Art & Design

This term in art we will learn about the artistic process and use this to create our own art inspired by artists from our local area. We will also develop our artistic opinions and begin talking about what we like or don't like about an art work.

Music

We are working on singing this term in preparation for our community showcase.



SCIENCE

Science

This term pupils will report and comment on scientific news items and explore the role science plays in their everyday lives.



TECHNOLOGY

Technology

We will be learning how to use our iPads as film cameras. Learning how to use controls, such as focus, microphones and editing. We will continue to use technology to support learning across the curriculum.
